

LOSS OF EMPLOYMENT 7/2020

Loss of employment rates are still high, with **16,660** new cases reported in July. Total LOE figures for 2020 now stand at **67,068**. **Closure of business** remains the leading cause of retrenchment, with the largest contributor to that being the **Manufacturing** sector.

JULY 2020 JOB LOSSES DECLINED BY **10%** M-O-M, BUT STILL REPRESENTED A Y-O-Y INCREASE.

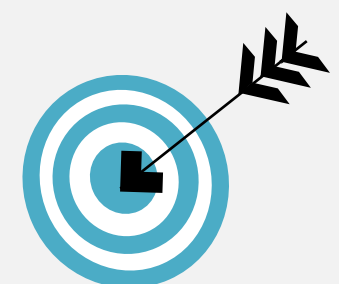

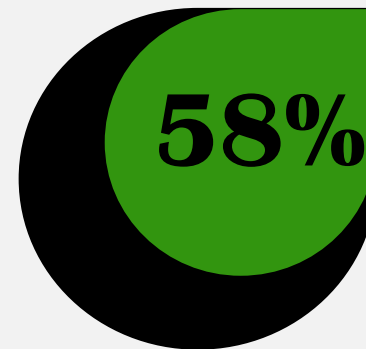


JOB PLACEMENTS 7/2020

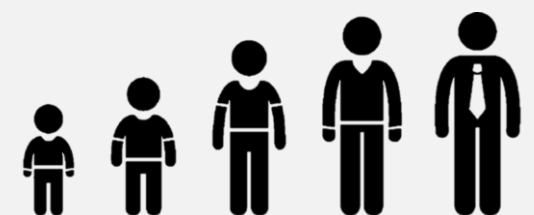
